

Post 95 House Rules

1. The following shall be admitted: American Legion Members, Auxiliary Members, SAL Members and their spouse and/or guest.
 - a. All members must have a current membership card.
 - b. All members are responsible for their guest, and their guest must leave when they do.
 - c. An eligible non-member may not come on a regular basis without joining.
2. Persons are expected to dress comfortable and desirably – clean clothes and well groomed. Attire such as short-shorts, obscene or revealing clothing or tank tops and sleeveless shirts for men are restricted.
3. Legionnaires and guest are expected to keep the post home clean. Please use the ash trays and garbage cans. No tobacco chewing allowed. Don't throw anything on the floor.
4. The House Manager, Bartender on duty, Commander or Executive Committee member shall have full authority to enforce House Rules and may eject any member or guest for misconduct of violation of House Rules. The member has right of appeal to the Executive Committee.
5. No member, Legion, SAL, or Auxiliary, shall undermine an officer or employee of the American Legion. Any suggestions or criticism of the Lounge or legion operation shall be submitted in writing to the House Manager, Commander or Executive Committee and will be given due consideration.
6. The employees on duty may refuse service to anyone for a just cause.
7. Any member purposely damaging or destroying property of the American Legion shall pay for same and be held accountable.
8. The cashing of two party checks, personal checks in excess of \$100 per day, credit or lending of Legion funds is strictly prohibited.
9. There shall positively be no drinking of alcohol during Legion meetings and no alcoholic beverages shall be brought into the meeting room.
10. No unruly member or guest shall be tolerated in the Lounge. Loud, boisterous or profane language will not be tolerated in Post Homes.
11. No beverage shall be taken off the premises without complying with State Laws and Alcoholic Beverage Commission regulations.
12. The Bartender, House Manager or Post Officers may check a member's card at any time.

13. Positively no alcoholic drinks are to be served to minors, and they are not allowed in the game room or to play amusement machines.
14. Dogs and other pets, except handicap assist animals, are not allowed in the Post home.
15. Absolutely no firearms are allowed in the building except Honor Guard equipment.
16. Only members and spouses can play amusement machines. Exceptions must be approved by the House Manager or Commander. Players are only allowed to play one machine at a time. No drinks or food allowed on top of the machines.
17. All forms of amusement shall stop 15 minutes before closing time.
18. Only authorized personnel are allowed behind the bar or in the kitchen.
19. Selling merchandise in the Lounge is not allowed without approval of the House Manager, Commander, or Executive Committee.
